

**RESOLUTION NO. 2006-3339**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MIAMI  
SPRINGS CANVASSING RETURNS OF THE  
SPECIAL ELECTION OF NOVEMBER 7, 2006,  
AND DECLARING RESULTS THEREOF**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Miami Springs enacted Resolution No. 2006-3322 on August 28, 2006, calling for the holding of a Special City Election on November 7, 2006; and,

**WHEREAS**, the aforesaid Special Election was duly and properly held and conducted in accordance with law on November 7, 2006; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is both necessary and proper for the City Council to canvass the returns of the Special Election of November 7, 2006, and officially declare the results thereof;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF MIAMI SPRINGS, FLORIDA:**

Section 1: That the returns of the Special Election held in and for the City of Miami Springs on November 7, 2006, have been properly canvassed.

Section 2: That the results of the canvassing of the ballots cast in the Special Election are as follows:

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO MIAMI SPRINGS CHARTER**

**Maximum Building Height:**

Buildings That Include More Than Two Residential Dwelling Units

Shall the Charter of the City of Miami Springs be amended to read as follows:

Any building that includes more than 2 residential dwelling units shall not exceed 3 stories and a maximum of 40-feet in height.
