

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-3472

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI SPRINGS AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO APPLY FOR, AND ACCEPT, IF AWARDED, A FOREST HEALTH IMPROVEMENT INITIATIVE GRANT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA; DIRECTING THE PROPER OFFICERS AND OFFICIALS OF THE CITY TO EXECUTE THE GRANT MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND CONSUMER SERVICES, DIVISION OF FORESTRY; EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the existing tree canopy and current designation as a “Tree City USA” are important factors to the City of Miami Springs and its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Springs is desirous of applying for a Forest Health Improvement Initiative Grant which would provide monies to improve the condition of the community’s tree canopy; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Miami Springs is desirous of authorizing the acceptance of the Forest Health Improvement Initiative Grant by the City; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Miami Springs hereby authorizes the proper officers and officials of the City to enter into a Forest Health Improvement Initiative Grant Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Miami Springs and the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI SPRINGS, FLORIDA:

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Section 1: That the City Council of the City of Miami Springs hereby authorizes the City to apply for, and accept, if awarded, a Forest Health Improvement Initiative Grant with the State of Florida.

Section 2: That the City Council of the City of Miami Springs hereby authorizes the proper officers and officials of the City to enter into a Forest Health Improvement Initiative Grant Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Miami Springs and the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
