<b>Day/Date</b>	<b>Activity</b>
<b>Monday 03/24/2014 1624 hrs</b>	Unknown subject(s) removed an iPad from the bench seat accidentally left behind by a customer at McDonalds Restaurant (4999 NW 36 Street). The estimated total loss is \$1,400.00.
<b>Tuesday 03/25/2014 0945 hrs</b>	Unknown subject(s) shattered the rear passenger side window of a vehicle and ransacked another while both were parked at a residence in the 1000 block of Meadowlark Avenue. Once inside the vehicles, a purse and miscellaneous personal items were removed, with a total estimated loss of \$1,091.00.
