Day/Date	Activity
Monday 10/08/2012 0904 hrs	Subject(s) slashed a patio screen then unlocked the door to enter a patio of an occupied residence in the 500 block of Glen Way. Once inside, subject(s) opened an interior storage room connected to the patio and removed a men's bicycle valued at \$246.00.
Monday 10/08/2012 1231 hrs	A residence in the 200 block of Carlisle Drive was entered by subject(s) throwing a rock to shatter the kitchen door. Once inside, subject(s) removed a rifle from a cabinet in the living room and two other rifles and a shotgun from the master bedroom closet. An estimated 1000 rounds of various calibers of ammunition were also removed along with two laptops and two backpacks. The estimated value of the property removed is \$7,995.00.
Tuesday 10/09/2012 1101 hrs	Subject(s) removed all four tires and rims from a vehicle parked at 3974 N.W. South River Drive (Embassy Suites) parking lot, leaving the vehicle on concrete blocks. The vehicle also has damage, possibly from a jack. The estimated loss is \$10,050.00; damage to the vehicle is estimated at \$10,000.00. A second vehicle also had its rims and tires removed at this location. The officer was unable to make contact with the owner to determine the value of the stolen property.
Tuesday 10/09/2012 1110 hrs	A vehicle parked in the 400 block of Desoto Drive had its rear window shattered by unknown means; no property was removed from the vehicle. The estimated damage is \$200.00.
Wednesday 10/10/2012 0917 hrs	A resident in the 100 block of Shadow Way discovered cash missing from a money bag which was in a top drawer of a desk located in a bedroom. The bag contained \$560.00.
Wednesday 10/10/2012 1309 hrs	Subject(s) removed eight hurricane shutters from the west side of a residence in the 300 block of Corydon Drive. The estimated loss is \$280.00.
