
- WAIT FOR SIGNALS. THEY ARE THERE FOR A REASON.

- IF YOU ARE PARTYING INSTEAD OF TRICK OR TREATING, DON'T DRINK AND DRIVE.















Miami Springs Historical Society Historian
1925 description "The Adams building on Broadway in Country Club Estates is
completed and tenanted throughout. In this building are the offices of the Everglades
Construction Corporation, the offices of Maj. B. H. Smith supervisor of construction for
Country Club Estates and contractor in charge of construction of many of the
residences, the office of Charles C. Stover architect who designed the building and also
is the architect for many homes under construction in that development, and the
completely equipped service station of the Everglades Construction Corporation. This
service station has been designed to carry full equipment of accessories for motor
vehicles. The gas is in concealed tanks in Spanish mission towers."

The overhang around the building was severely damaged in the Great Miami
Hurricane of 1926 and not replaced. This building became the Miami Springs city hall
and was demolished in 1964 to be replaced with the current city hall.
We speculate that the man shown in the photo is Everglades Construction
Corporation owner Carl Adams looking at his half brother Glenn Curtiss's Curtiss Bright
Administration Building just 2 blocks away.
