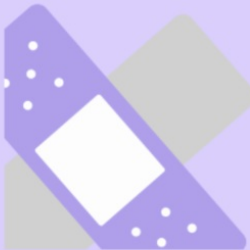

NATURAL GAS PIPELINE WORK BEGINS



OVERVIEW

The Florida Gas Transmission Company, LLC (FGT) will conduct pipeline maintenance work on its 12-inch Miami Lateral natural gas pipeline. This pipeline section generally runs along SR 948/NW 36 Street in Miami-Dade County.

During the work, the following lane closures will occur:

- Westbound SR 948/NW 36 Street will be reduced from three lanes down to two lanes from SR 953/NW 42 Avenue/Le Jeune Road, for one block, to just west of Coolidge Drive
- Eastbound SR 948/NW 36 Street will be reduced from three lanes down to two lanes from just west of Coolidge Drive, for one block, to SR 953/NW 42 Avenue/Le Jeune Road

Expect delays in the area.

The work and lane closures will begin on Sunday, 1 May 2022 and the lane closures will continue through until Sunday, 15 May 2022.

COMIENZAN LOS TRABAJOS EN EL GASODUCTO DE GAS NATURAL



INFORMACIÓN GENERAL

La Florida Gas Transmission Company, LLC (FGT) llevará a cabo trabajos de mantenimiento en las tuberías de gas natural lateral de Miami de 12 pulgadas. Esta sección del gasoducto generalmente corre a lo largo de SR 948/NW 36 Street en el condado de Miami-Dade.

Durante la prueba, ocurrirán los siguientes cierres:

- La SR 948/NW 36 Street en dirección oeste se reducirá de tres carriles a dos carriles desde SR 953/NW 42 Avenue/Le Jeune Road, por una cuadra, hasta justo al oeste de Coolidge Drive
- La SR 948/NW 36 Street en dirección este se reducirá de tres carriles a dos carriles desde el oeste de Coolidge Drive, por una cuadra, hasta la SR 953/NW 42 Avenue/Le Jeune Road

Se esperan retrasos en el área.

Las obras y cierres de carriles comenzarán el domingo 1 de mayo de 2022 y los cierres de carriles continuarán hasta el domingo 15 de mayo de 2022.

Please be aware, if you engage in short-term vacation rentals, you risk losing your homestead exemption in accordance with Florida Statute 196.061

If you are a homeowner who rents out all or a substantial amount of your homestead property for more than 30 days per year for two consecutive years, you will lose your homestead exemption and will be subject to penalties.

Residents of Miami Springs **must** have a city license to operate or will face severe fines.

Any property operating a short-term rental without a city license will be fined \$250 for the first offense and \$500 for the second offense. fined up to \$5,000 for violations that are irreparable or irreversible (such as violation of noise ordinance)

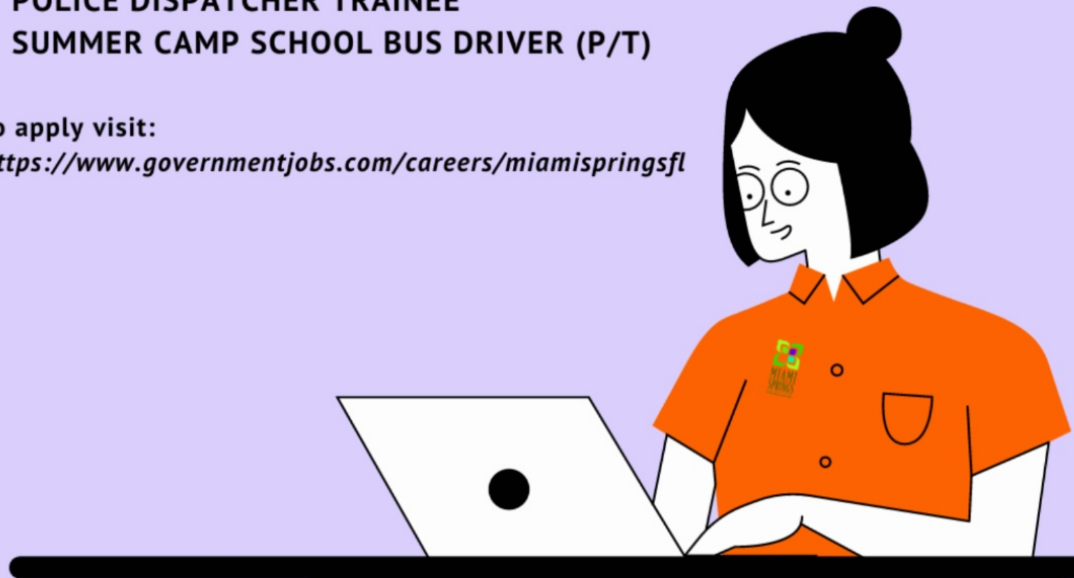

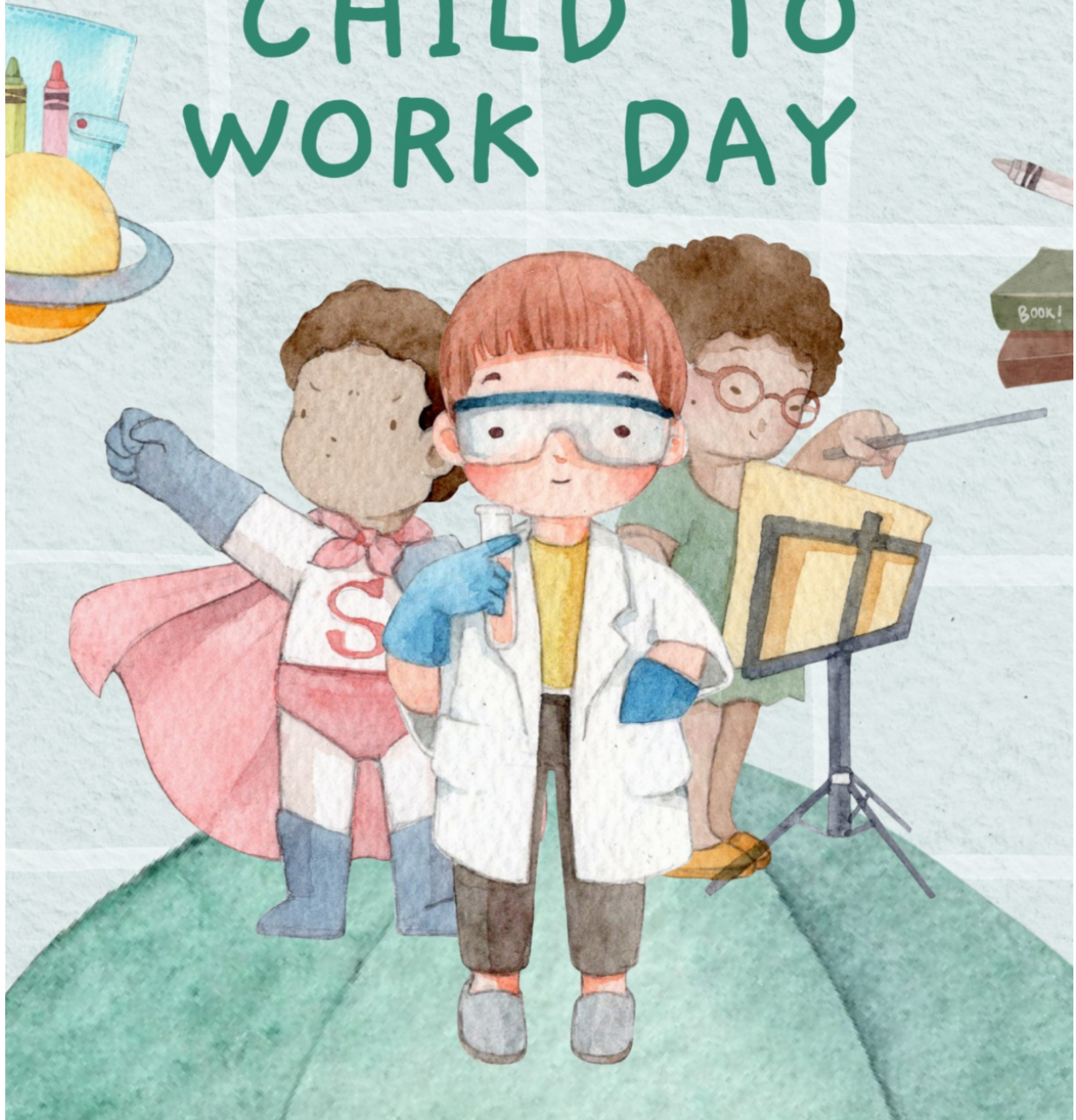

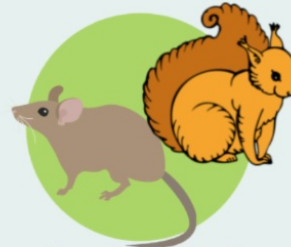
