

MONKEYPOX

Follow these Do's and Don'ts to Prevent Getting Monkeypox

Do

- Wash your hands often with soap and water or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Talk to a healthcare provider about your risk of getting monkeypox and available vaccines.

Don't

- Nave close, skin-to-skin contact with people who have a rash that looks like monkeypox.
- Touch the rash, cuddle, kiss, or share utensils and cups of a person with monkeypox.
- Name and the hedding, towels, or clothing of a person with monkeypox.


BENEFITS OF ANNEXATION


- Availability of the City Manager, Building Official, Planning and Zoning Director and the Chief of Police to meet face to face.
- Personal representation by the City of Miami Springs Lobbyist, Commissioner, Senator and State Representatives at the local, state and federal level.
- Personalized, efficient, and timely service from our City Departments; Building and Zoning Department, Public Works Department, Police and Community Policing Departments.
- Establish a new district by ordinance to address the needs specific to this commercial and industrial area.
- Enhance the commercial and industrial district with roadway, landscaping and lighting improvements.
- Develop Master Stormwater Plan for future stormwater improvement project.
- Make improvements and capital investments for the benefit of increased property values in the coming years.
- Commitment to lower millage rates moving forward, with current projections beginning between 3.7 and 3.9 mills the first year.






