


IN DECEMBER 2021, THE CITY'S RESIDENTS EXPERIENCED SIGNIFICANT NOISE DISTURBANCES CAUSED BY EVENTS OCCURRING AT AN ENTERTAINMENT VENUE KNOWN AS FACTORY TOWN, OUTSIDE OF THE CITY'S LIMITS. THE NOISE LED TO OVER 243 COMPLAINTS TO THE CITY'S POLICE DEPARTMENT. IN RESPONSE TO THE COMPLAINTS AND AS REQUIRED BY STATE LAW, THE CITY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE ISSUED TWO NOTICES TO FACTORY TOWN'S OWNERS DEMANDING THAT THE NOISE BE ABATED. FACTORY TOWN DID NOT RESPOND TO ANY OF THE NOTICES SENT BY THE CITY. ACCORDINGLY, IN AN EFFORT TO PROTECT THE MIAMI SPRINGS COMMUNITY FROM CONTINUED AND FUTURE NUISANCES, ON FRIDAY, JANUARY 21, 2022 THE CITY ATTORNEY FILED A LAWSUIT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF MIAMI SPRINGS AGAINST FACTORY TOWN TO ENJOIN FACTORY TOWN FROM CAUSING FURTHER NUISANCES. THE CITY WILL CONTINUE TO PURSUE ALL AVENUES TO PROTECT ITS RESIDENTS AND AVOID FUTURE DISTURBANCES.

NEIGHBORING CITY OF VIRGINIA GARDENS.












"THIS MONTH'S EXHIBIT WILL FEATURE THE BEST AND THE BRIGHTEST OF MIAMI SPRINGS SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL LEVELS 1, 2, AND 3 ART CLASSES. THESE CLASSES COVER A RANGE OF TOPICS SUCH AS DRAWING, TWO-DIMENSIONAL DESIGN, THREE-DIMENSIONAL DESIGN, FINE CRAFTS, 3D, AND CERAMICS. THE STUDENTS PARTICIPATING ARE IN THE 9TH, 10TH, 11TH, AND 12TH GRADES.

THIS FIRST SHOW FOR THE MONTH OF FEBRUARY WILL FEATURE SELF-PORTRAITS AND SELFIES. DRAWING CLASSES WILL BE DONE IN TRADITIONAL PENCIL AND PAPER. TWO-DIMENSIONAL STUDENTS WERE ASKED TO USE A SELFIE AND PLACE A FILTER CONVERTING THE PORTRAITS TO FOCUS ON THE VALUE PATTERNS AND SHAPES LIGHTING CREATES ON THE FACE. THEY WERE ASKED TO CREATE A REPRODUCTION OF THIS WITH PENCIL AND PAPER. THE 2D STUDENTS WERE ASKED TO DO A SERIES OF DESIGN PROJECTS USING THIS FACE CONCEPT. SOME OF THE WORKS WERE MADE USING SHAPES AND COLOR LAYERS, THESE PIECES BEING LAYERED TO CREATE THEIR FACES. OTHERS WERE CREATED WITH SMALL PIECES OF TORN MAGAZINE PAGES COLLAGED TOGETHER TO CREATE THEIR FACES."


