

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020 – 3859**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI SPRINGS, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR ACCESS TO CERTAIN EXEMPT INFORMATION MAINTAINED BY THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Miami Springs (the “City”) Council currently collects certain solid waste fees as a non-ad valorem assessment on the property tax bill using information provided by the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser (the “Property Appraiser”); and

**WHEREAS**, recent changes to Chapter 119, “Public Records,” of the Florida Statutes exempt certain information that the Property Appraiser provides to the City in order to impose non-ad valorem assessments; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to enter into an Agreement for Access to Certain Exempt Information Maintained by the Property Appraiser, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit “A,” (the “Agreement”) to continue obtaining exempt information used for the imposition and collection of non-ad valorem assessments; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that this Resolution is in the best interest and welfare of the residents of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI SPRINGS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Recitals.** That each of the above-stated recitals are hereby adopted, confirmed, and incorporated herein.

**Section 2. Approval.** That the City Council approves the Agreement in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit “A.”

**Section 3. Authorization.** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the Agreement, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit “A,” subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form, content, and legal sufficiency.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Councilman Best who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Zapata and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:


